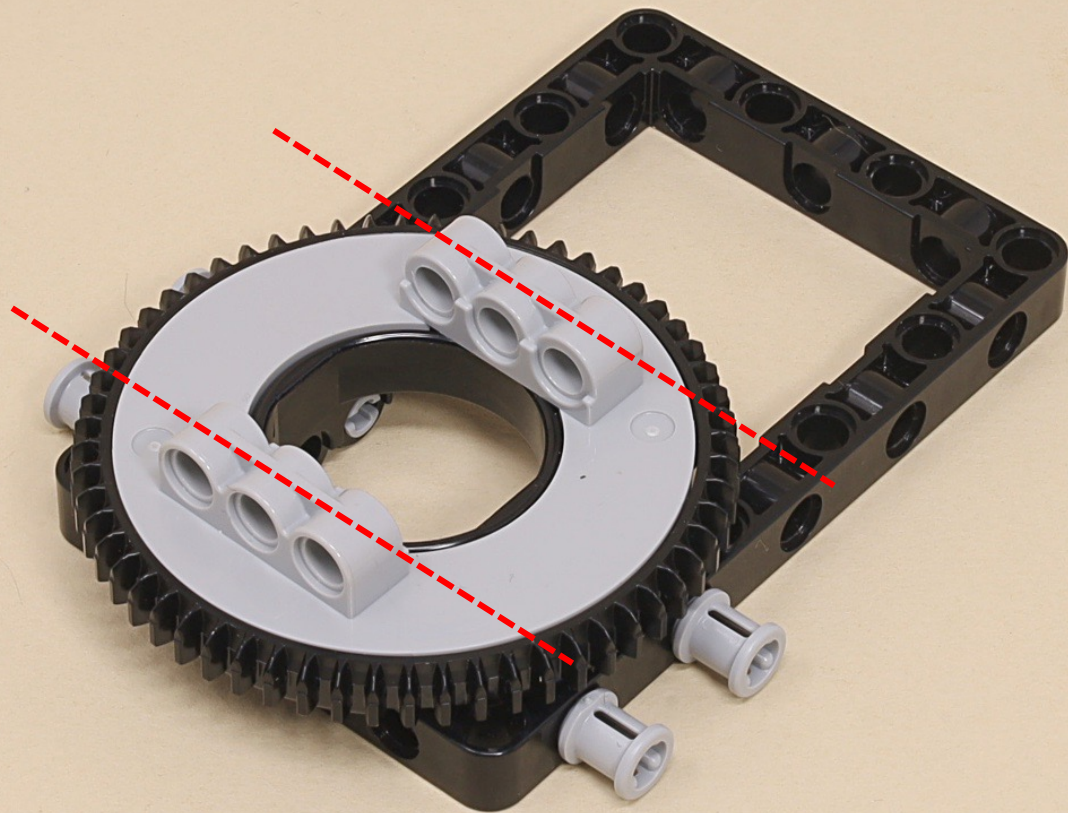


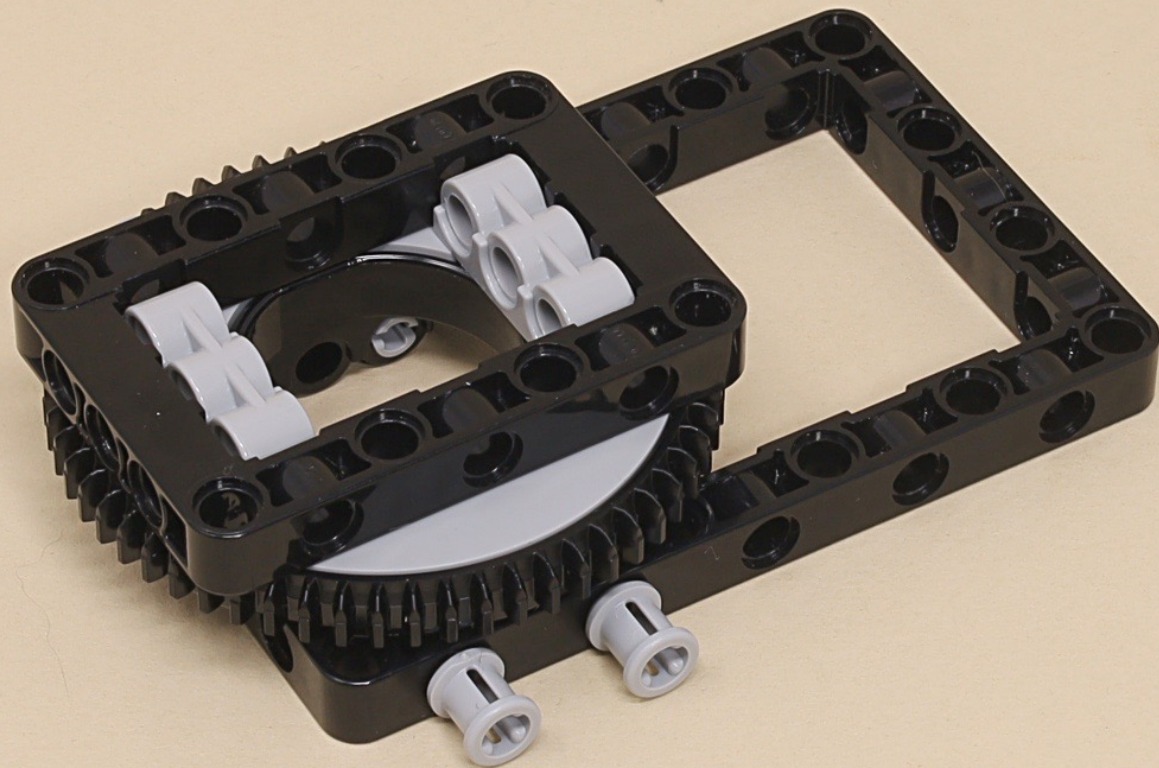
Snap the black and gray halves of the large turntable together if you haven't already, and position it black side up as shown.

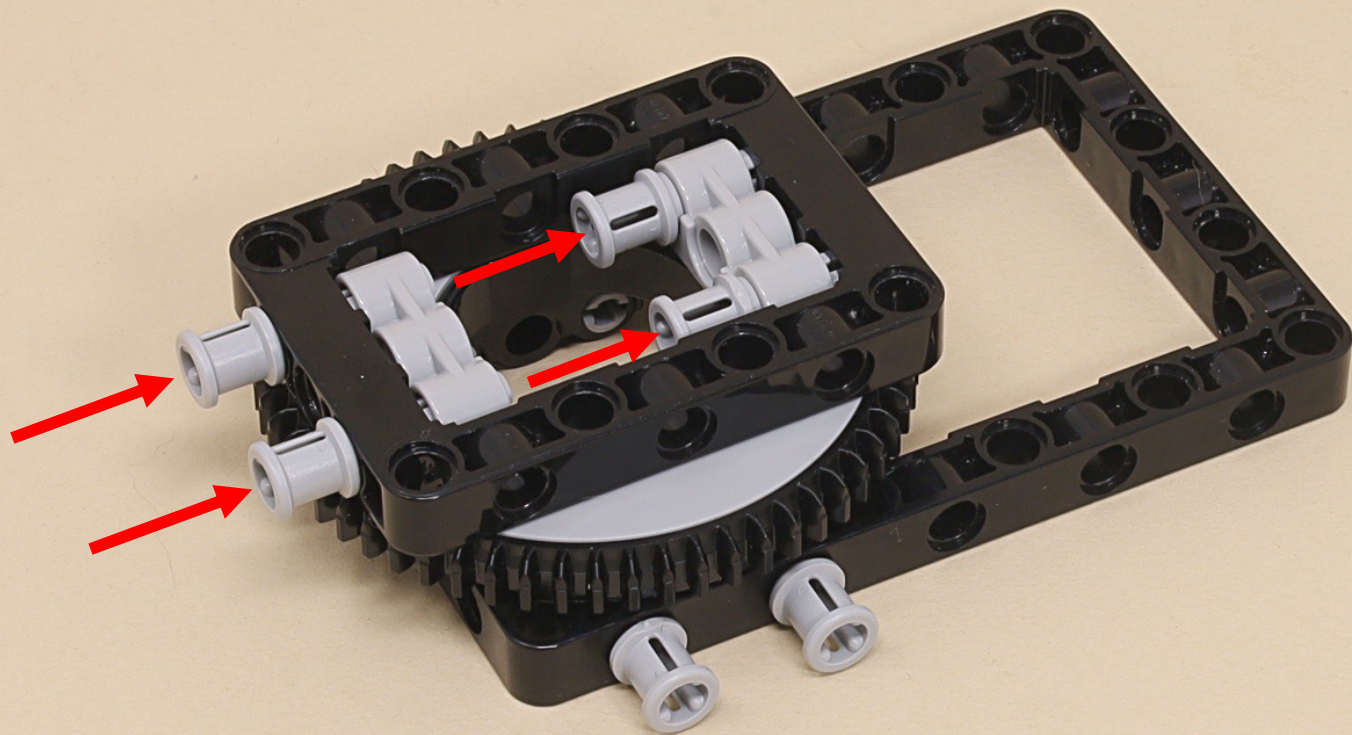


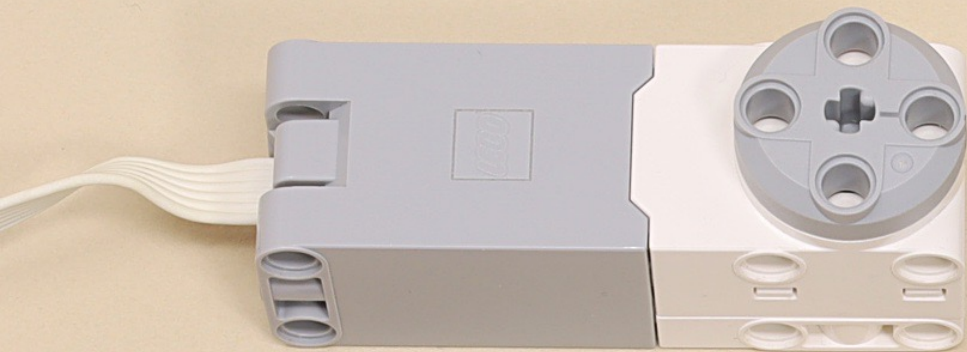








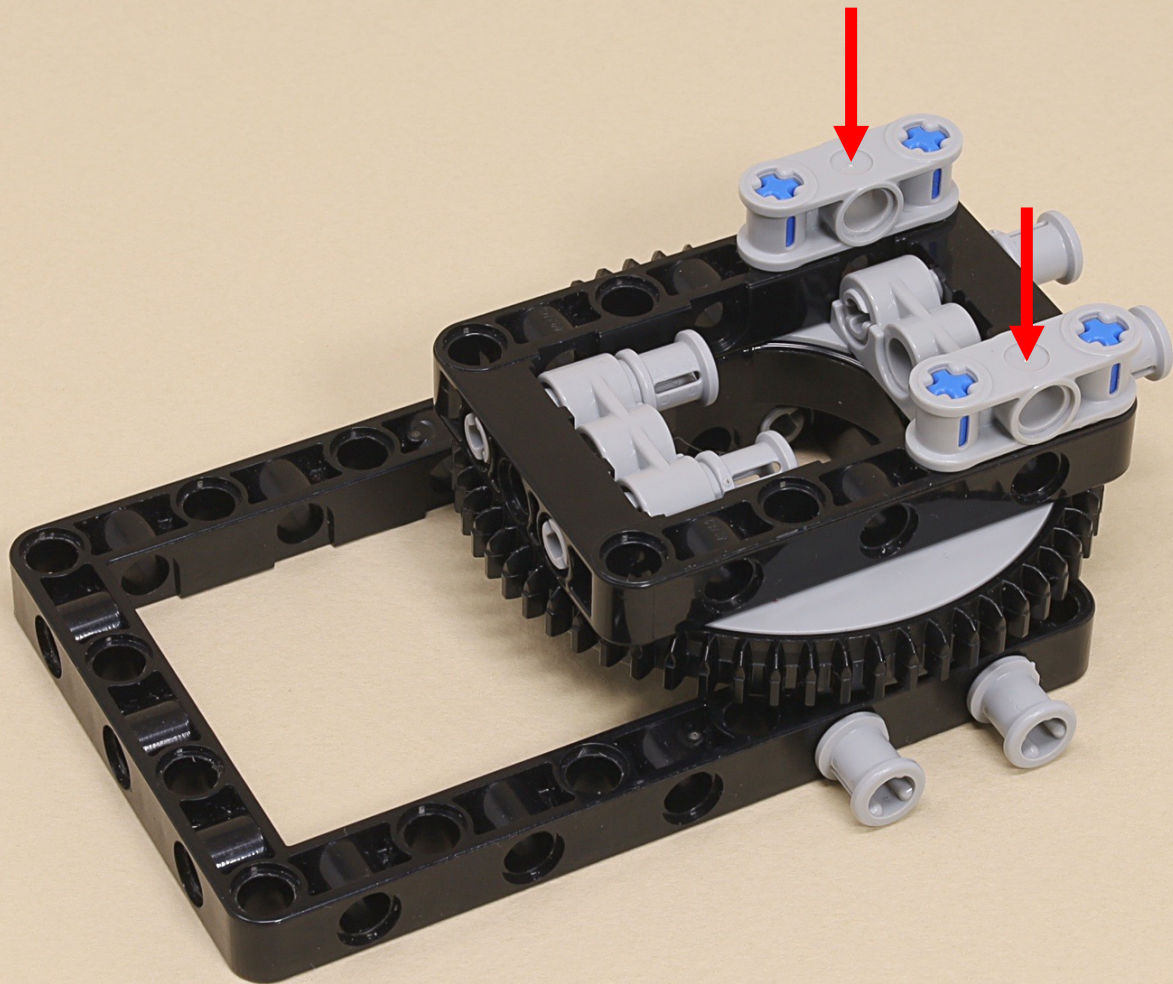


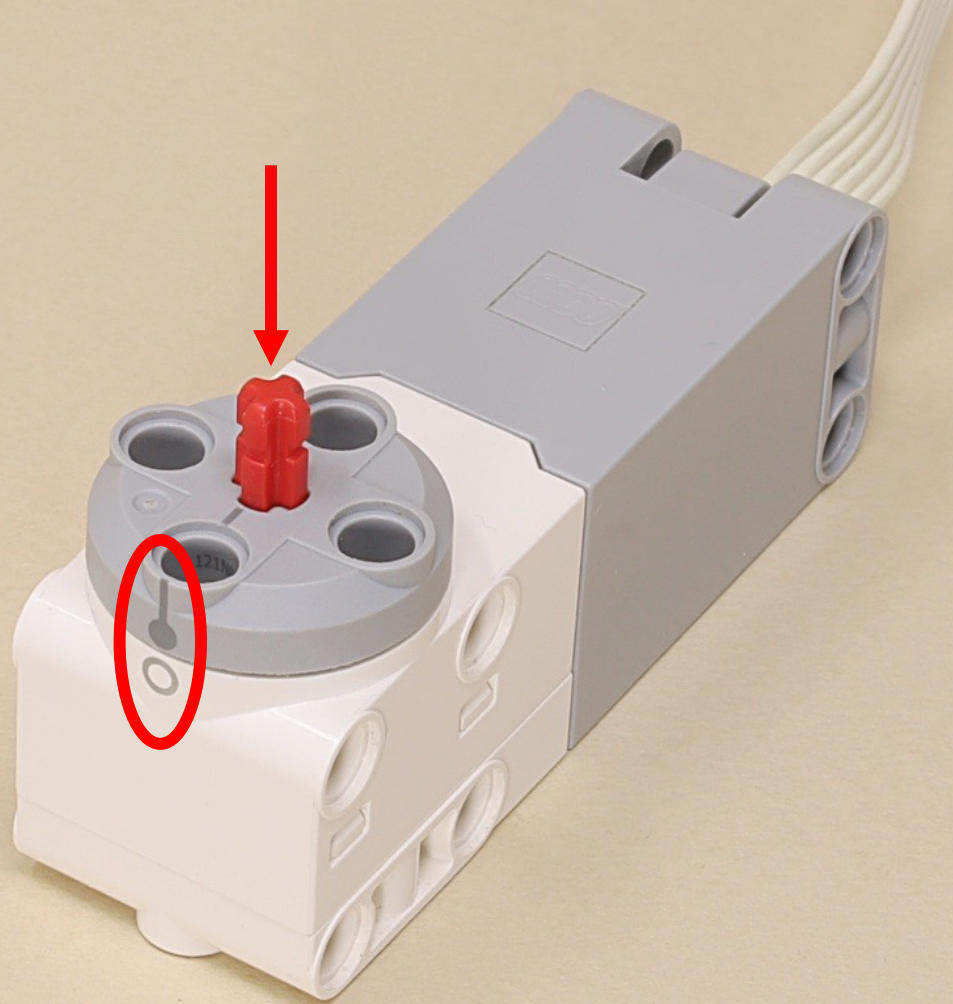


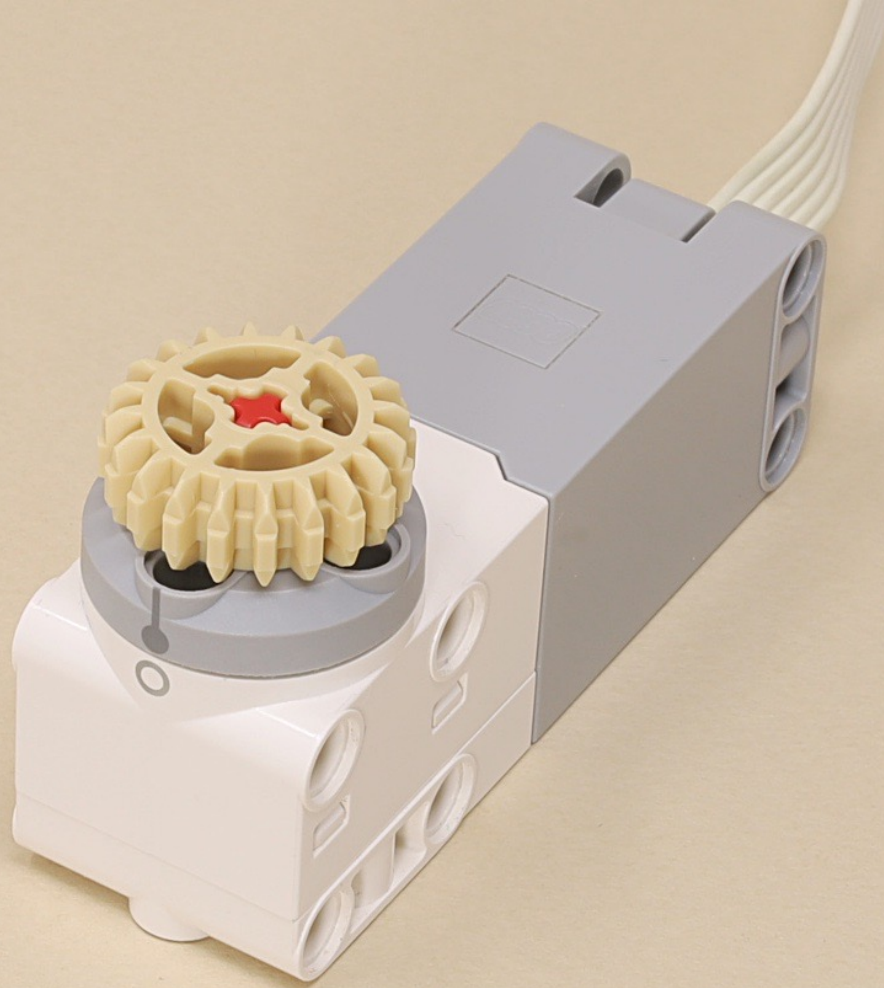

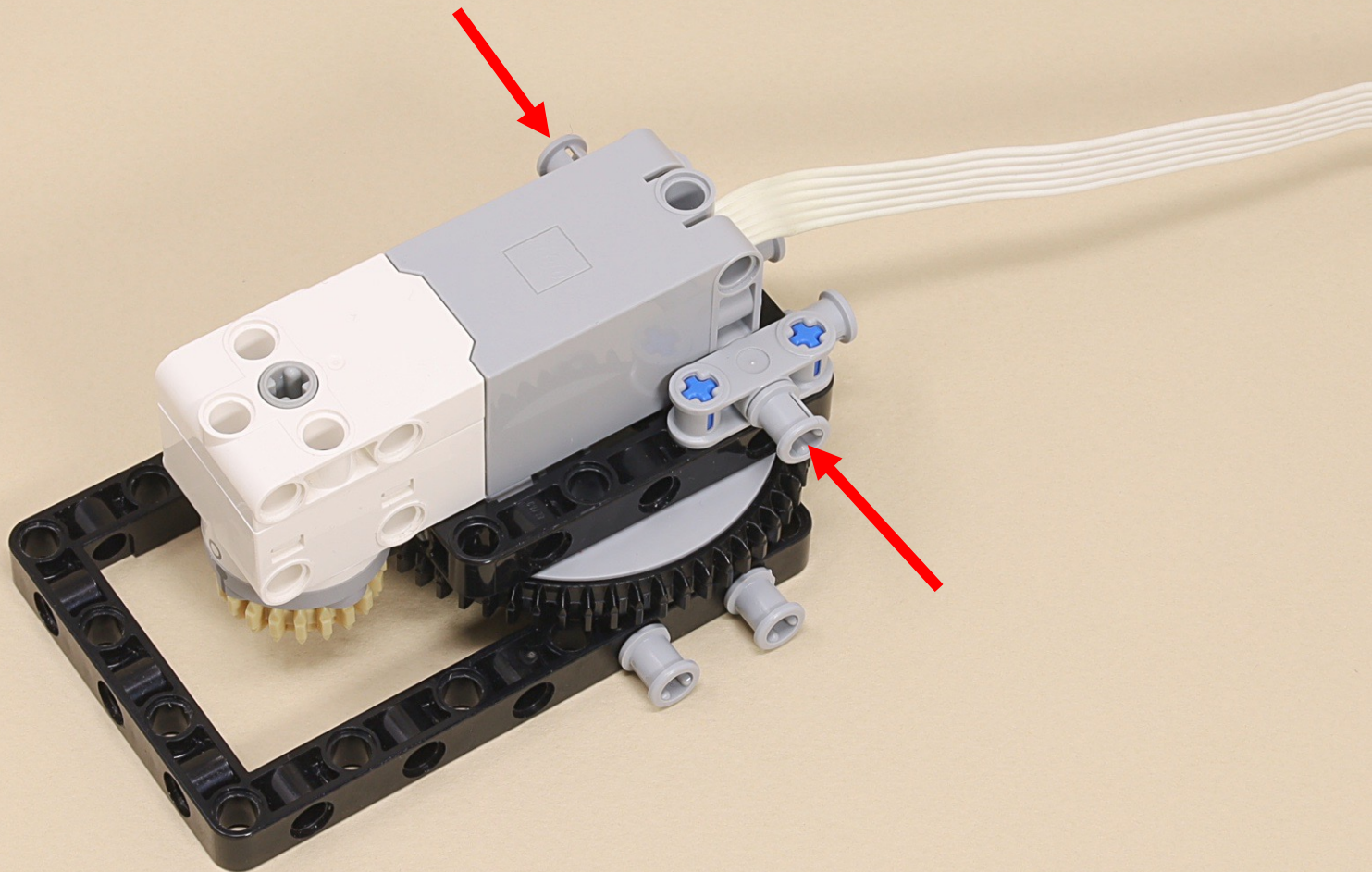


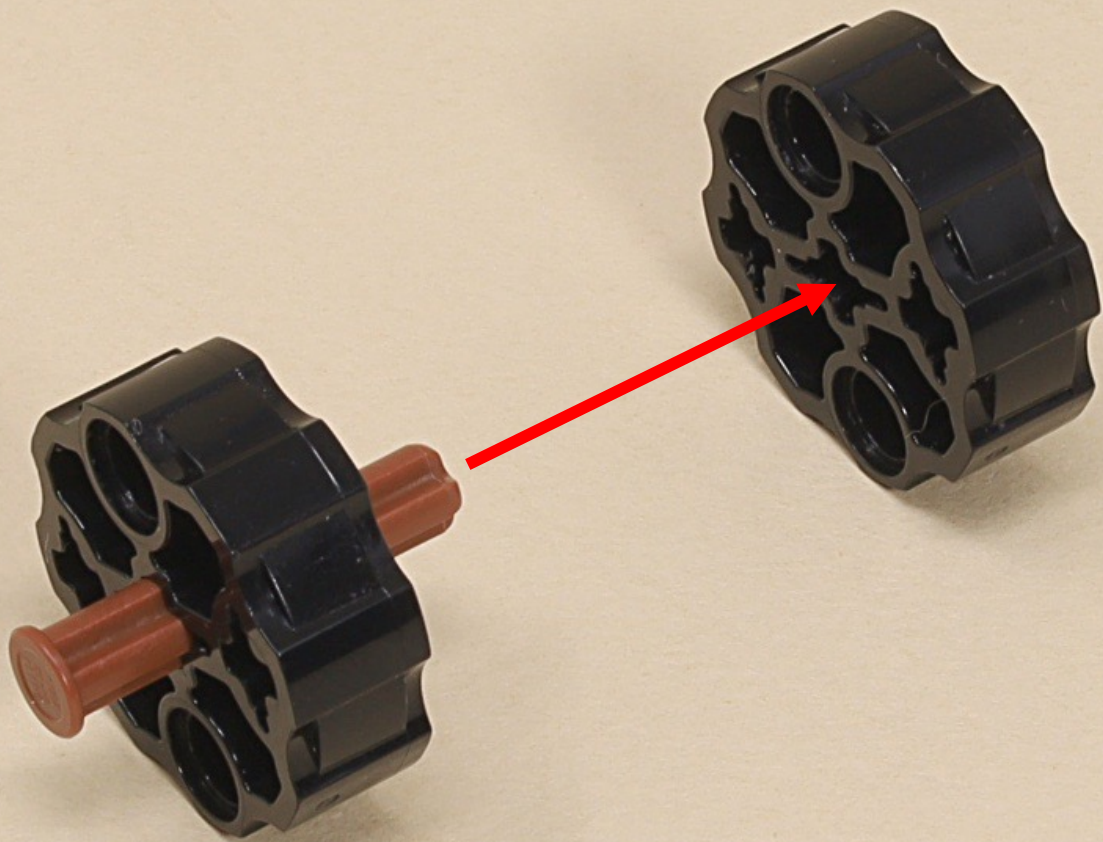


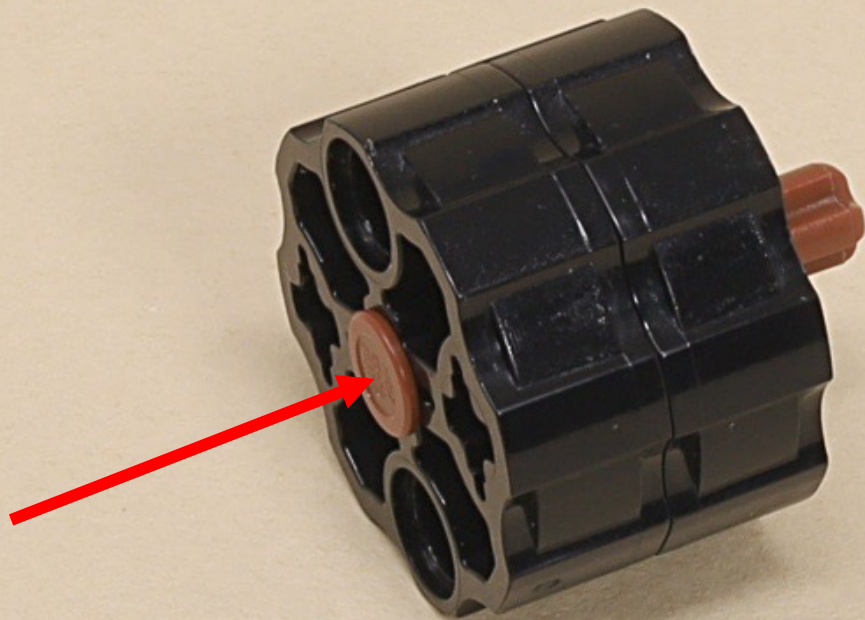




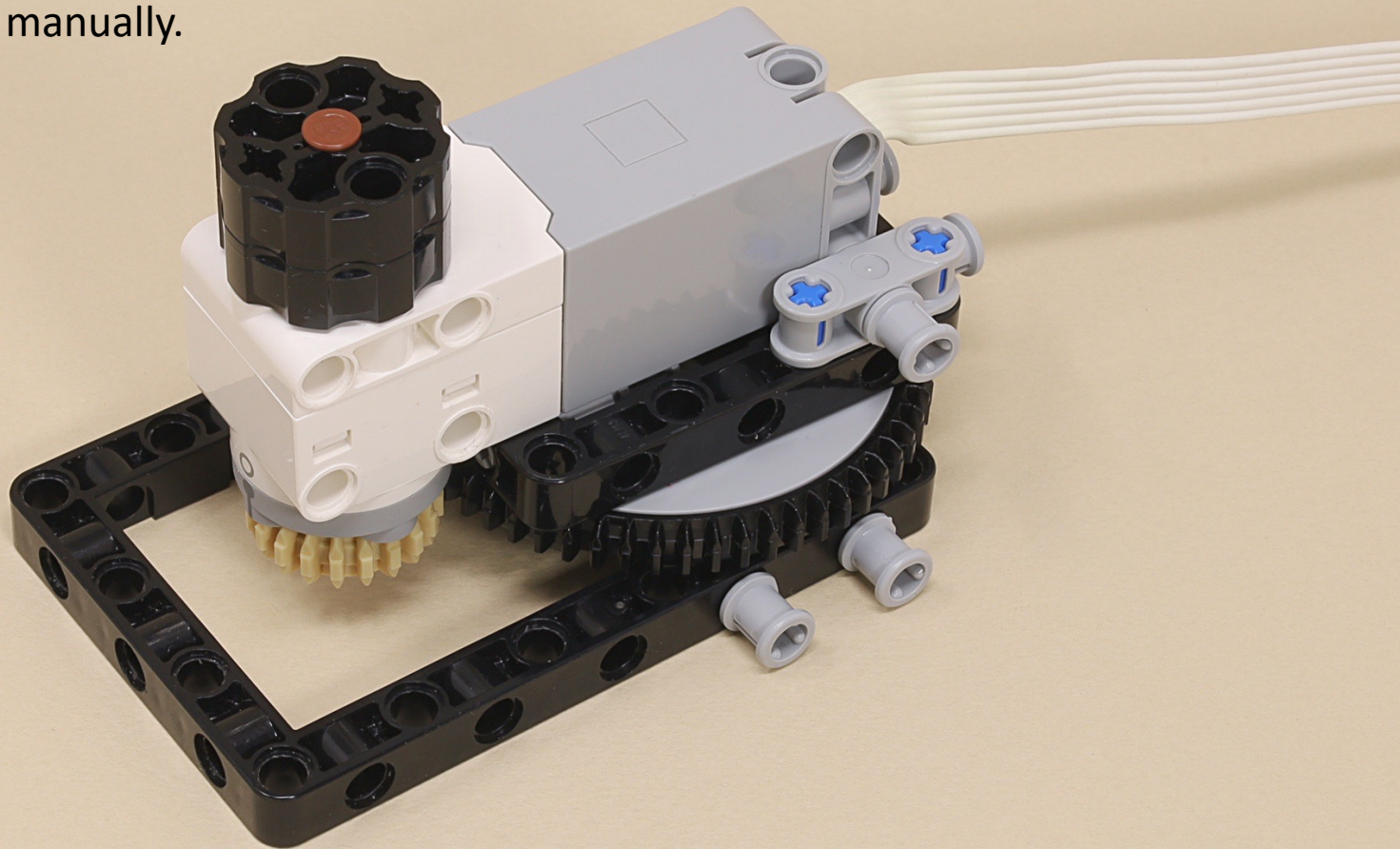


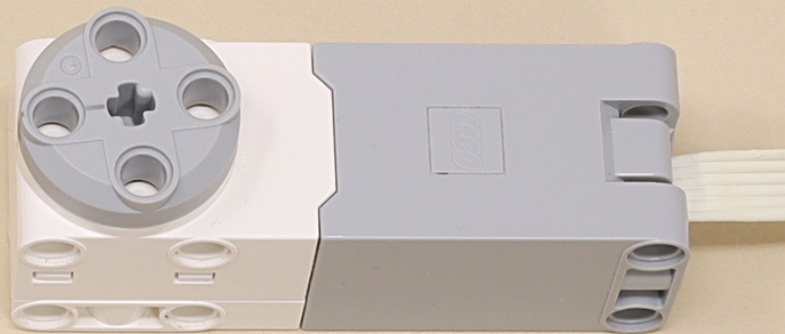
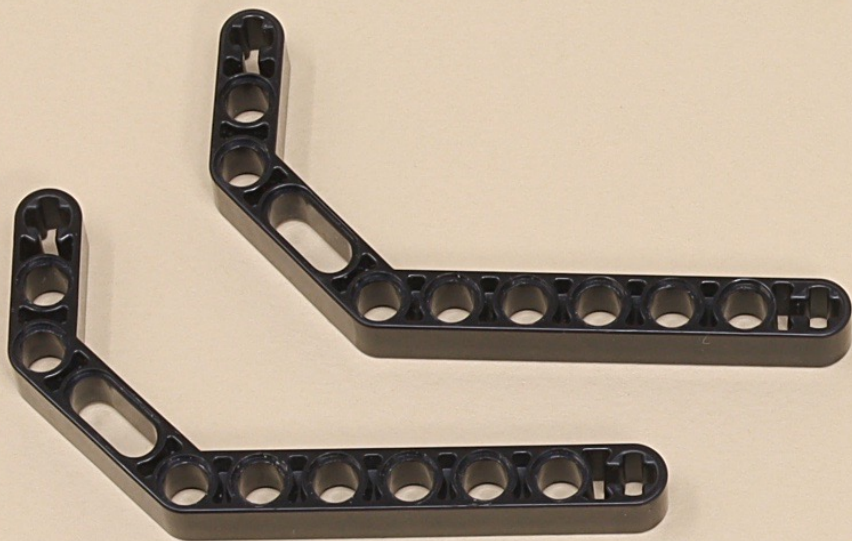






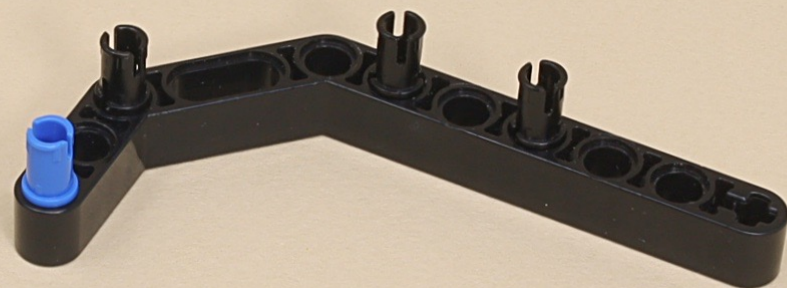
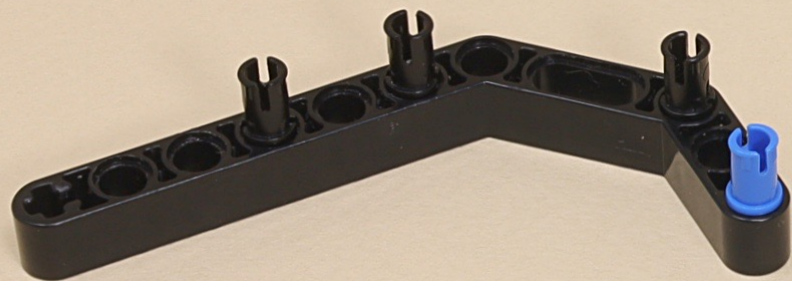
You can use this knob to adjust the turntable angle manually.

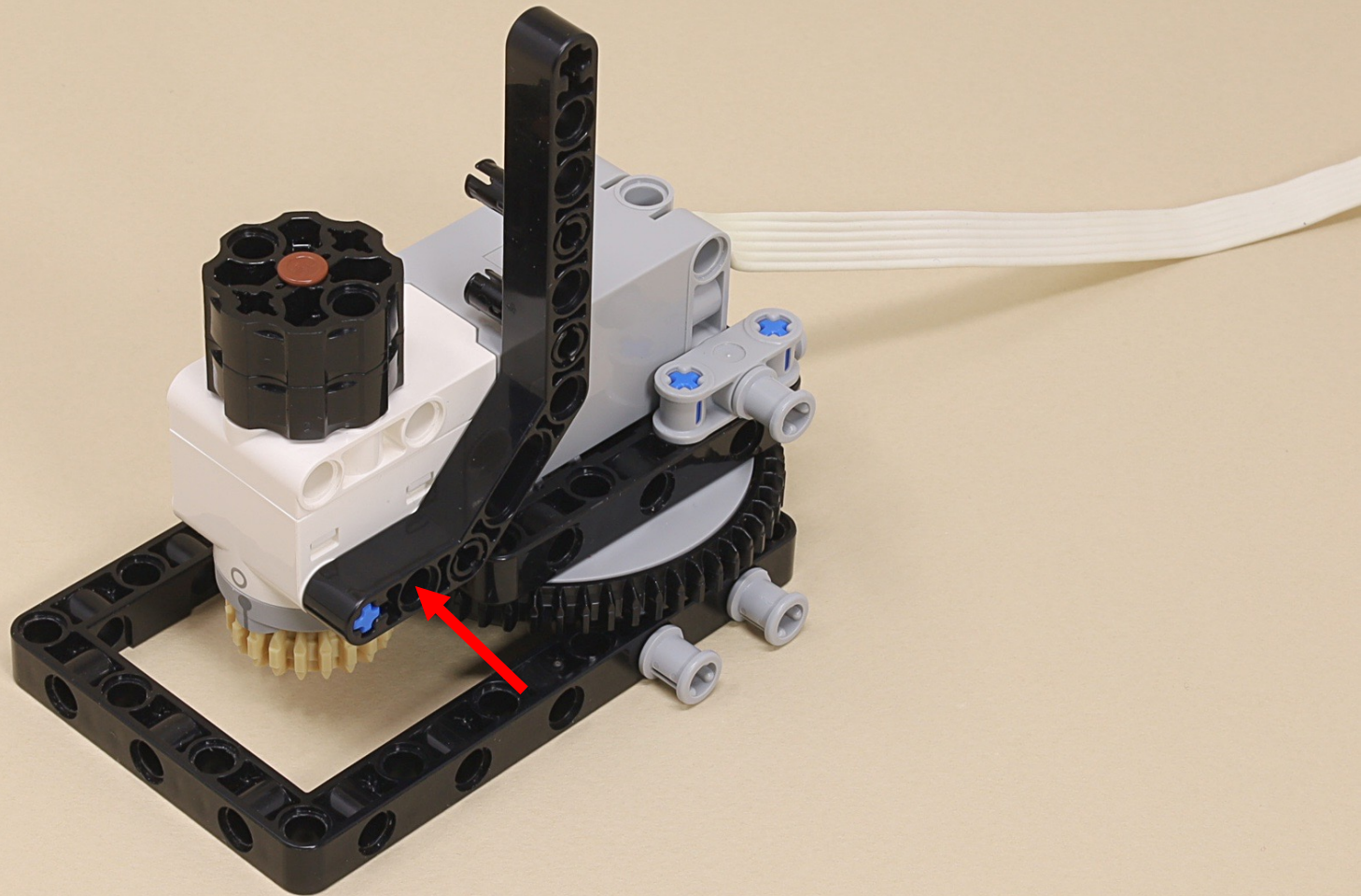


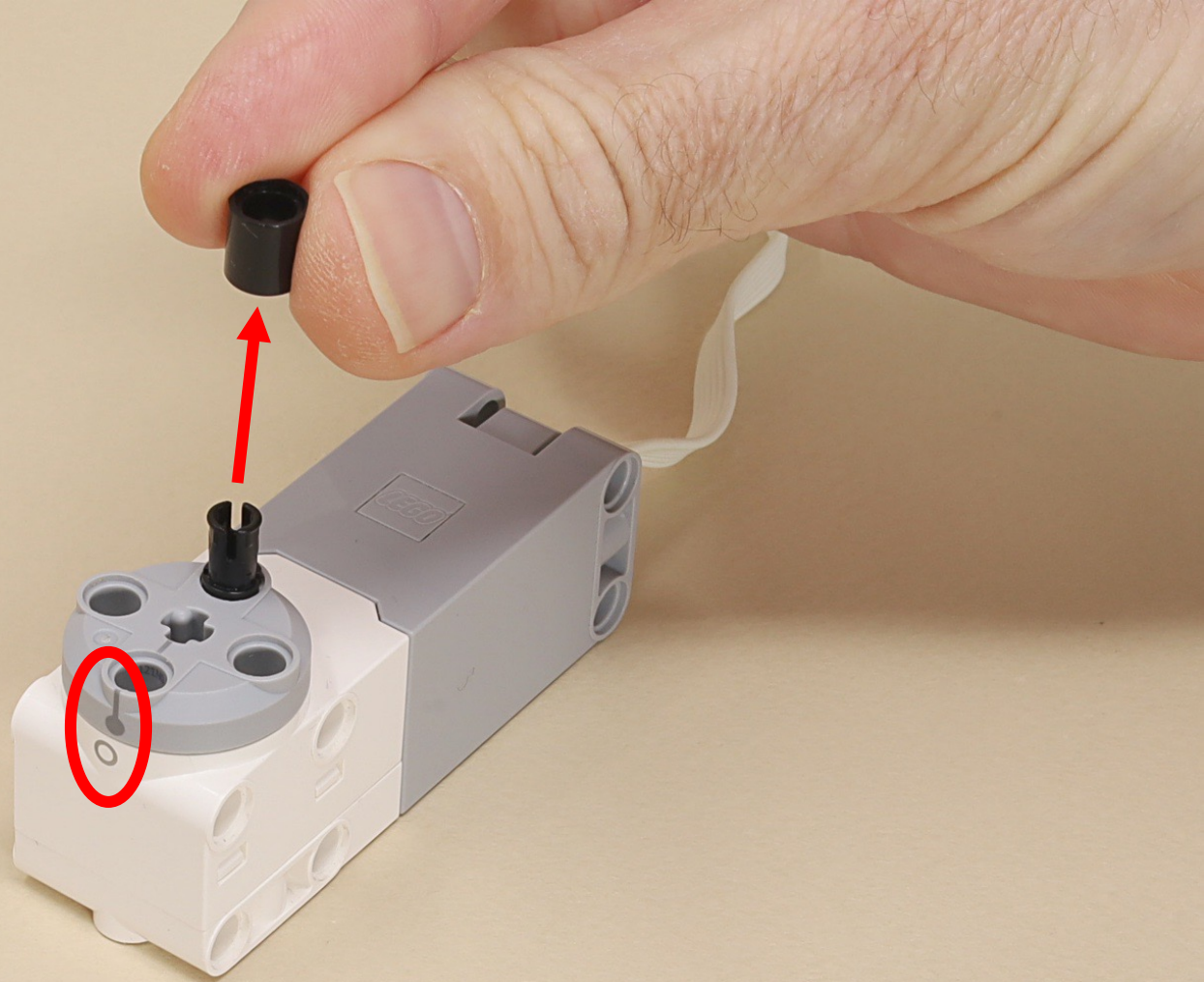


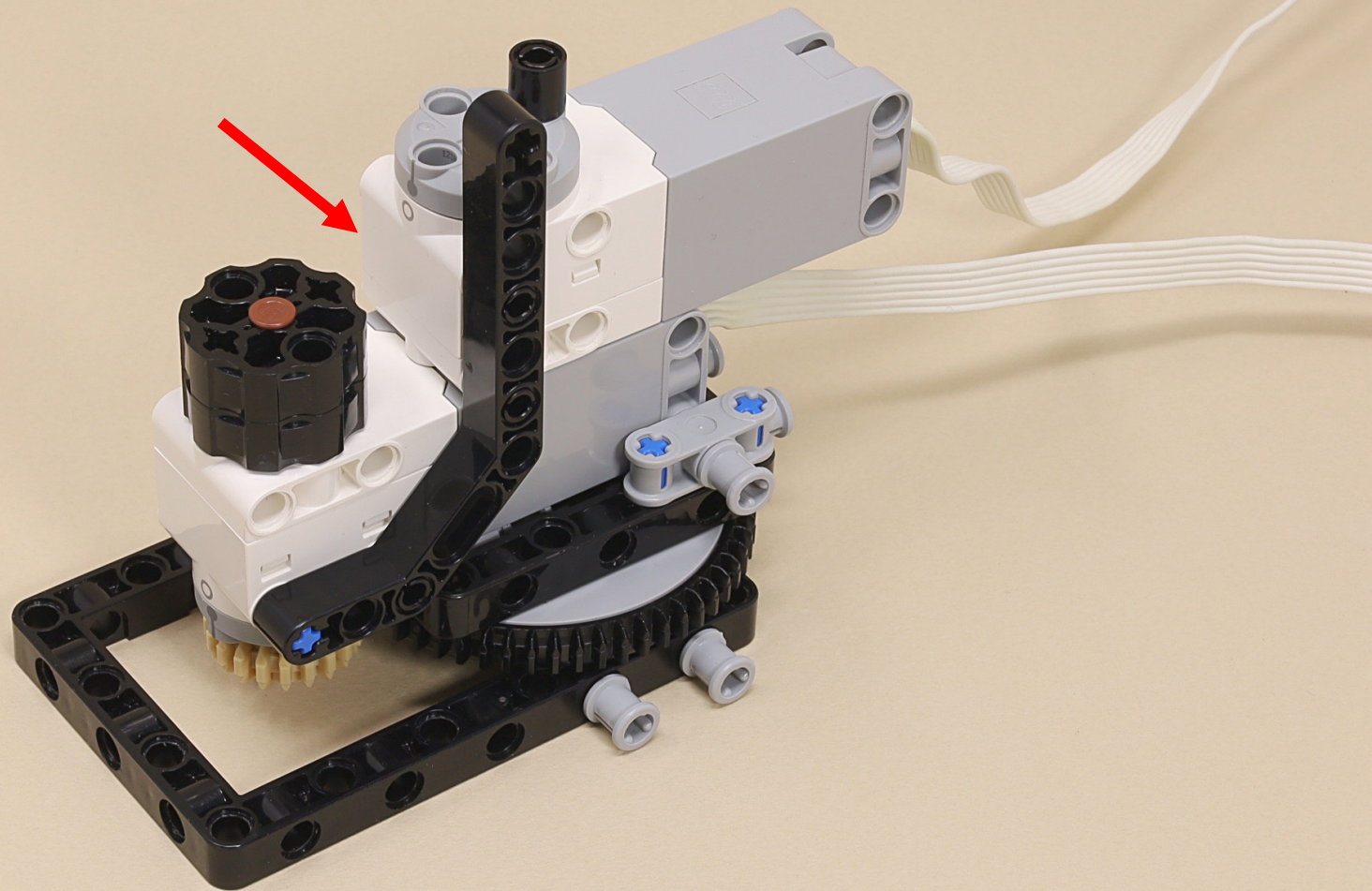

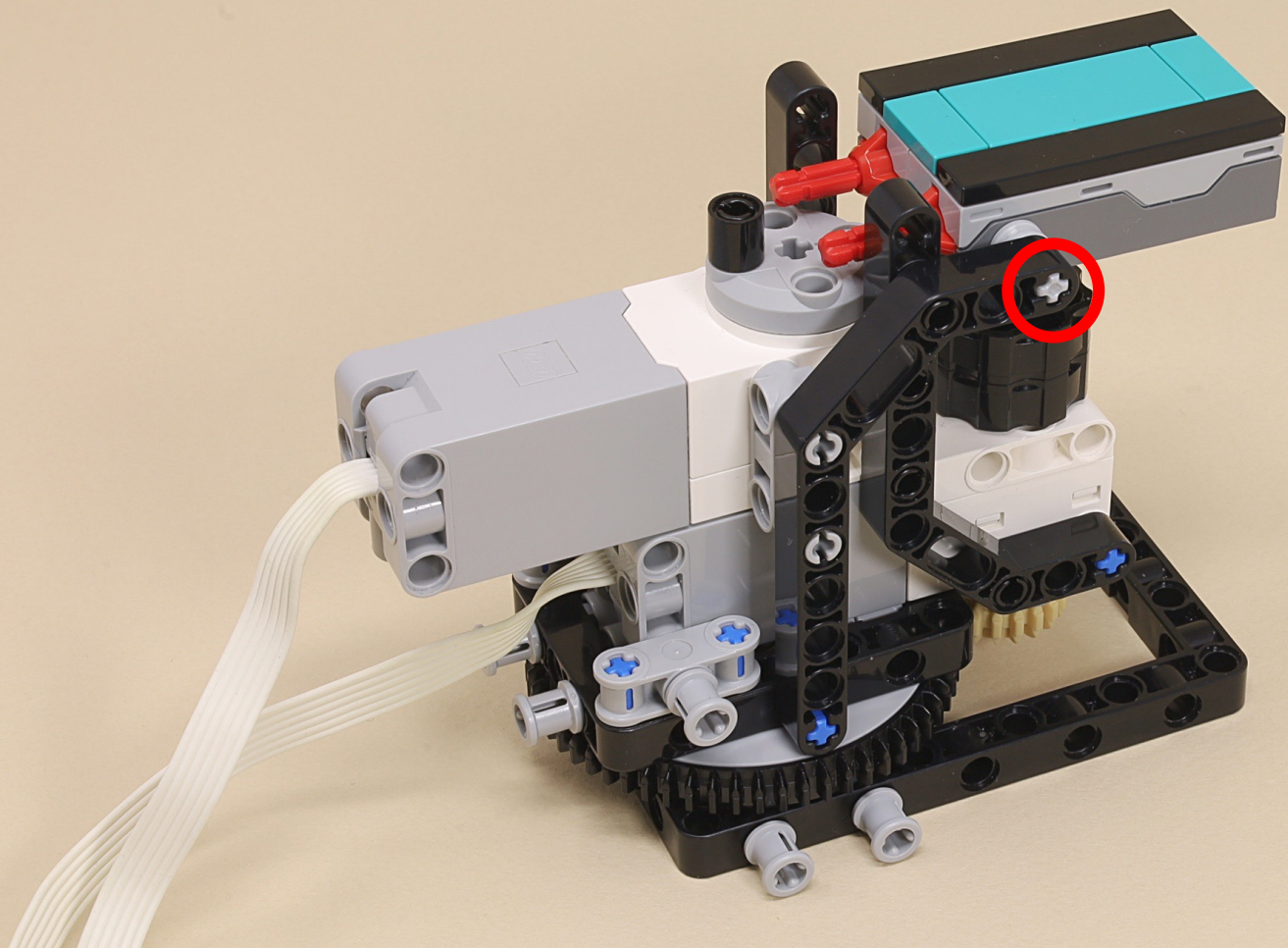


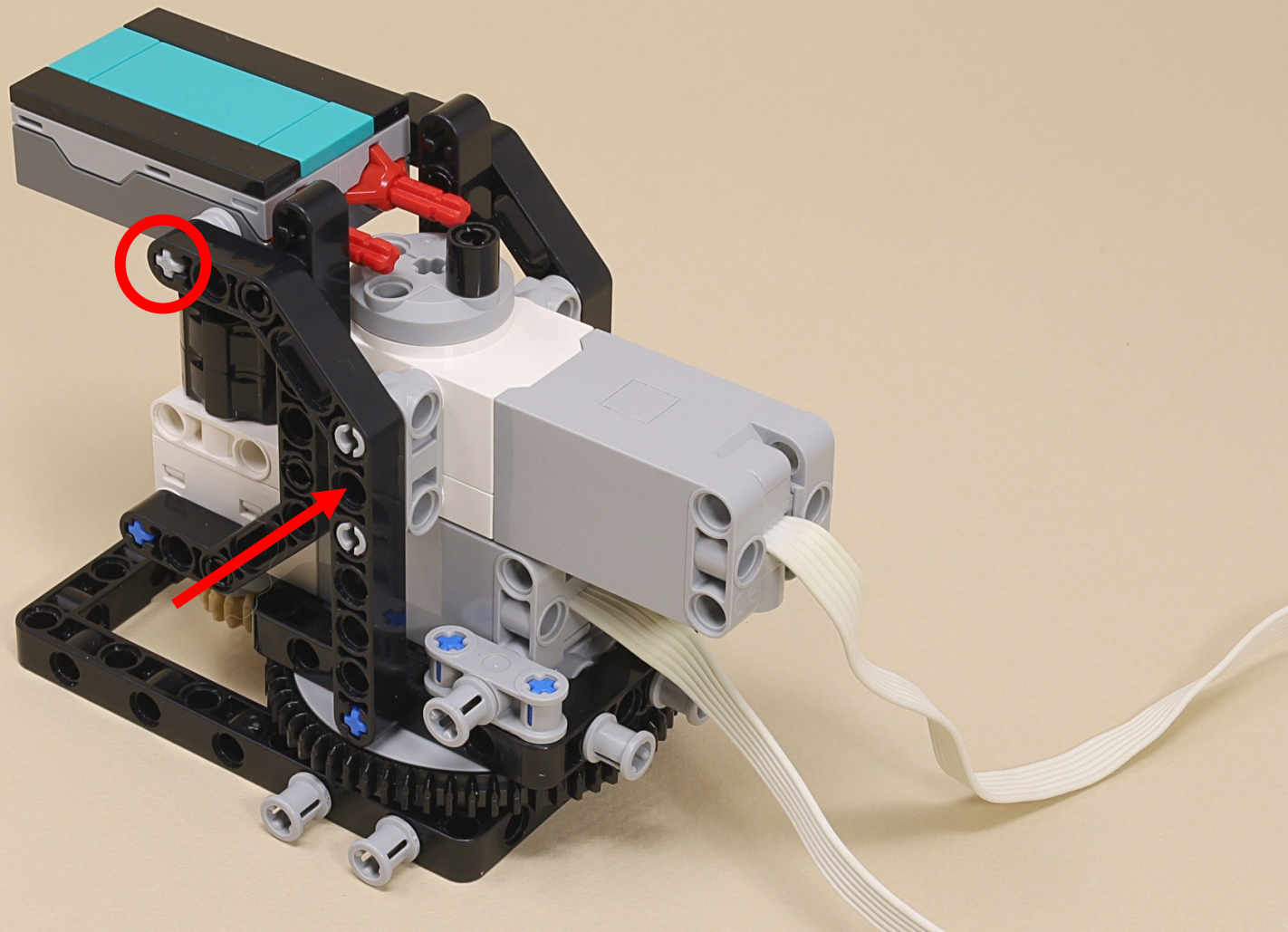


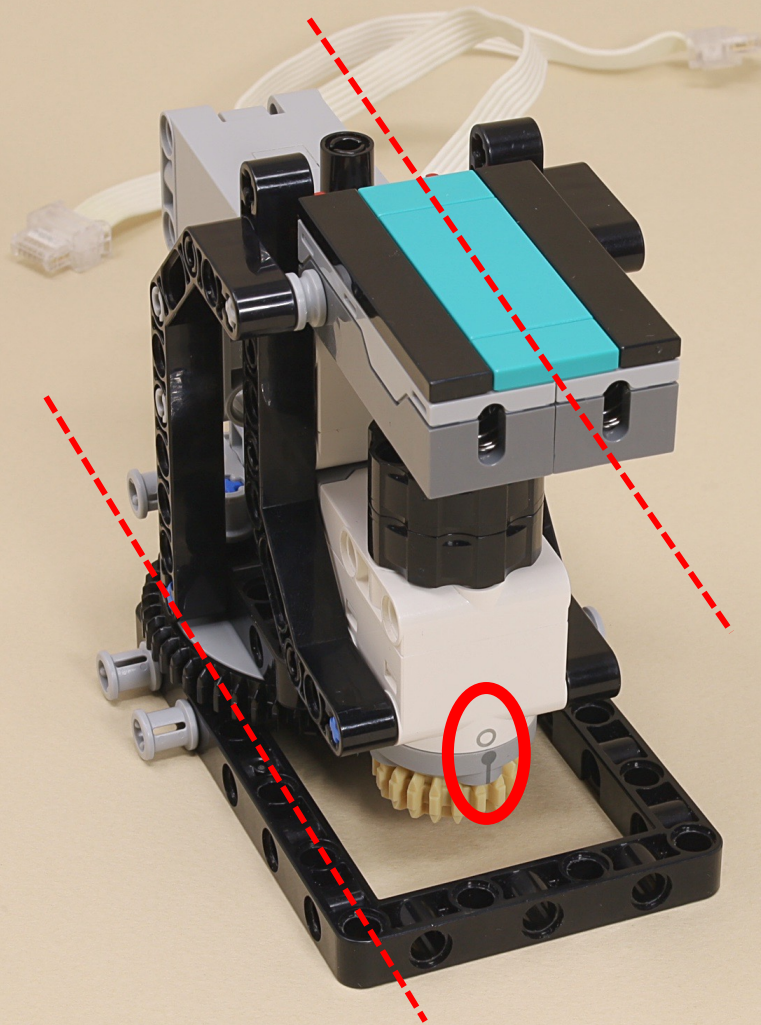












Make sure the turret is aligned straight when the motor is in its zero position.
